1. That the petitioners had chosen to file a petition before  
the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India wherein the

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India while dealing with the petition asked the petitioners to approach the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir by way of proper petition and accordingly the petitioners chose to file a petition in a representative capacity under OWP 610/2007, (**Copy of the same is enclosed as Annexure - P1**), and the Hon'ble Single Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir while dealing with the petition after full dressed arguments disposed of the said petition in terms of Order dated 09.10.2013 passed by the Hon'ble Single Bench in the above stated petition (**Copy of the same enclosed as Annexure - P2**).

2. That finding no response in the government machinery and administrative bodies within the Valley of Kashmir interested in the implementation of the Judgment the petitioners were forced to file the contempt petition which was duly diarized as Contempt Petition No. 572/2014 (**Copy of the same is enclosed herewith as Annexure - P3**) and notices were issued to all of the respondents for submission of status report and till date only respondent no. 5 and 10 seems to have applied to the court with the statement of facts, and Contempt Petition came to listed on 04.03.2015 before the Hon'ble Single Bench wherein the Single Bench was pleased to ask the petitioners to submit further and better particulars and pleadings so as to enable the respondents to implement the judgment of the Hon'ble Court in letter and spirit.
