(Rehabilitation of Kashmir Pandit Community living in Kashmir)

A meeting was held in the premises of Ganesh Mandir, Ganpatyar, Habba Kadal, in which the members of the Community especially youths participated. All the matters regarding the rehabilitation of the Community were discussed in length and breadth. It was urged that in the priority the left out Kashmiri Pandit needs to be rehabilitated by extending the PM's Relief and Rehabilitation Package to the Community living in Kashmir.
