(Issue related to Non Migrant Certificate)

Time and again the State Administration and its machinery are creating hostile conditions for the Kashmiri Pandit Community living within the four walls of Kashmir Valley.

On the one hand State Government claims in Kashmir Valley there are 808 families who never chose to leave the Valley since 1990 armed uprising and on the other side the same administration asks these families to get “Non-Migrant Certificate” for even to breath in the Valley.

In a recent case, if a member of Kashmiri Pandit Community who chose to live with all the odds in the Valley, tries to sell his house to move to a better place in the Valley, he is compelled to get “Non-Migrant” Certificate from the Jammu, even if he produces all the relevant record like telephone bills, electricity bills, Voter ID Card, Ration Card, Employment Card still the concerned authority refuses to accept the same for want of “Non-Migrant Certificate”

It is quite embarrassing that even after 21 years State Government and its Machineries is do not owns this miniscule population.

Today KPSS met with delegation of Amnesty International and discussed this issue also in length and breadth alongwith other relevant issues pertaining to the Kashmir and Kashmiri Pandits as this is one of the best examples of “Human Right Violation” by the State Actors.

In present times this is one of the biggest questions before the Kashmiri Pandit Community that “why is this left out Community living in the Valley to get humiliated again and again by the State Government and its machineries?”
